# Printing Instructions for Pantry Organization Labels (Avery 22806)

## Materials Needed:

- Avery 22806 Pantry Organization Labels
- Printer (preferably high-quality inkjet or laser)
- Computer with internet access

#### Instructions:

- 1. Prepare Your Design:
  - Open your design file for the Avery 22806 labels on your computer.
  - Ensure the design fits within the label dimensions.

#### 2. Load Labels into Printer:

- Open the label sheet package and load the Avery 22806 label sheets into your printer's paper tray.

- Allow the labels to dry completely before handling to avoid smudging.
